

Maryland Hunting Heritage Protection Act – October 2006

REPORTING YEAR – August 1, 2005 – July 31, 2006 (2005-2006 season)

ACREAGE AVAILABLE FOR HUNTING AS OF JULY 31, 2006 – 365,479 acres

ACREAGE REMOVED FROM HUNTABLE AREA FOR THE 2005-2006 SEASON – 600± acres in the Clopper Area of Seneca Creek State Park, that had been open to a managed deer hunt the previous year, was discontinued due to a short duration staffing shortage.

ACREAGE ADDED INTO HUNTABLE AREA FOR THE 2005-2006 SEASON – 1000± acres opened to bow hunting at Seneca Creek State Park and 800± acres opened to forest and upland game at Patuxent River State Park.
